### **3. Introduction to the Committee**

#### **a. What is F-WHO?**

The World Health Organization (WHO) is a specialized agency of the United Nations, established in 1948. It is responsible for directing and coordinating international efforts in the field of public health. However The Futuristic World Health Organization (F-WHO) is an advanced, speculative evolution of the World Health Organization (WHO) convened under extraordinary circumstances following solving crises during sessions. This committee operates beyond conventional WHO authority, combining global health governance, biosecurity oversight, and emergency executive powers granted by a special UN General Assembly mandate. This committee exists for one purpose: To think extraordinary and also don't forget, you will shape the future with your own hands.

#### **b. Committee Procedures**

This committee will operate in a semi-crisis format which means we will both resolve a crisis and write a resolution. The meetings will include the following key concepts:

*General Speakers List (GSL):* The GSL is essentially your default section within a discussion. Chairs will establish a time limit that each speaker should adhere to, and Countries can then ask to be added to the list, taking turns to speak in the order the Chairs have provided.

*Motion:* In short, a “motion” is a proposal. To discuss a topic in detail, you need to submit a motion. This will help generate solutions for the resolution paper that the committee will draft at the end.

*Moderated Caucus:* A moderated caucus requires speakers to only hold speeches based on the topic at hand. It might be fruitful to raise a motion for a moderated caucus on a certain topic (for a certain amount of minutes, with a certain amount of speakers time), if, within the GSL, a trend towards such a topic was already foreseeable.

*Semi-Moderated Caucus:* A semi-moderated format will be used to integrate the incoming crisis directives into the discussions. This format will allow delegates on the committee to both defend their national interests and develop solutions that are in line with the common goals.

*Unmoderated Caucus:* An Unmoderated caucus is a time where debate is not structured by the chair and provides a more open conversation. It's a particularly valuable time to work with your bloc on your working paper.

*Directives:* A directive is the main tool delegates use to take action. It is a formal written document that outlines the actions your cabinet or character wants to implement. Directives must be specific, actionable, and realistic within the context of the scenario. The crisis team reviews directives and decides their outcomes.

There are many types of directives;

- Information Directive: Asks for guidance and updates on certain topics.
- Individual Directive: Issues specific tasks or responsibilities to a single person.
- Joint Directive: Coordinates actions among multiple parties for a shared objective.
- Top Secret: Highest classification for sensitive information critical to security.

## 4. Introduction to the Topic

### a. Key Terms

***SCP Foundation:*** A secret foundation linked to a powerful elite and led by Dr. Who. The foundation's core principles are stated as establishing peace and justice in the world.

***Dr. Who:*** President of the SCP Foundation. A professor whose name is unknown even to the elite. He has sometimes made headlines for his work on human genomes.

***Alpha Zombies:*** Each zombie group is led by an alpha zombie. These zombies are stronger, more intelligent, and have the ability to control the other zombies. Zombie tactics played a major role in the fall of half of Italy's territory.

***Egg Plantations:*** This is how zombies reproduce. In the densely forested areas they take over, zombies combine with the power of nature to form eggs. After growing in eggs for 3 weeks, the zombies hatch from the eggs under the power of nature and also these zombies are faster and stronger.

***Vaccination Initiatives:*** Although there is currently no confirmed information from a reliable source, many research groups are working on a treatment for the vaccine. The status of the tests and their results is uncertain...

***NATO:*** NATO is playing an active role in attacks against zombies, primarily in Europe, Poland, and the United States. Some reinforcement units are assisting with fortifications in Poland, another group is helping to strengthen fortifications in the Balkans.

***The General Situation in Europe:*** The future of Europe is currently uncertain, and Italy's critical situation in particular has pushed many neighboring countries to take harsh measures. For example, France could completely clear the area from the Italian border to the city of Nice of people and animals. The French Army planted landmines in the area.

***New defense lines:*** As a result of the increasing zombie attacks, many countries have adopted this strategy in order to minimize human casualties. The United States has decided to divide the country into two parts. In Europe, Poland and the Balkan Alliance are establishing a similar defensive line. NATO is also providing assistance in setting up the necessary defensive lines.

## **5. Historical Background of the Outrage**

### **a. Emergence and Detection of the Virus**

Everything began with the awakening of an ancient defense mechanism, dating back to the dark pages of human history, to the year 10,000 BC, when our ancestors attempted to stop creatures unlike any human or other being by using “fire and extreme cold.” In addition, legends say that 300 Spartans fought not only the Persians, but also their immortal armies. The Spartans found a way to suppress the virus, but this knowledge was somehow erased from history.

This ancient viral genome, which lay dormant for thousands of years under the deep glaciers of Greenland, laid the foundations for disaster when it was discovered about 50 years ago and brought to the city of Wuhan, China, one of the world's largest research centers.

By the end of 2021, the SCP Foundation and global elites led by Dr. Who modified this genome in high-security laboratories around Wuhan, designing nature's most terrifying biological weapon to solve the “overpopulation” problem. In these secret facilities, the virus was given not only lethal power, but also complete resistance to antibiotics, a practical mindset, and the ability to multiply rapidly through “egg plantations.”

When the “Patient Zero” and the first infected individuals began to appear on the streets of Wuhan in the final months of 2021, security forces intervened violently to suppress the situation, while the Chinese Communist Party concealed the events as an “internal security matter,” keeping the entire world behind a veil of secrecy. However, the virus, which underwent accelerated evolution in the laboratory environment, was not only killing people, but also transforming them into advanced hunters capable of using weapons and preserving the memories and skills of their victims.

This deep silence, which lasted until the first months of 2022, was broken when the situation in Wuhan crossed the “critical threshold”; neither high walls nor censorship mechanisms were now sufficient to conceal this biological chaos.

The huge surge in the number of zombies caused great turmoil within Wuhan and put world governments on alert. European countries France and Italy immediately sent passenger planes to the region to evacuate their citizens. However, the airport security was overrun by zombies, causing great chaos inside. While only those without symptoms were allowed on the Italian planes, several infected individuals managed to board during this time.

While the plane took off from Wuhan and was heading to Rome, the carriers slowly began to turn into zombies and attacked the other passengers and crew. Finally, with the captain also becoming infected, the plane completely lost control and crashed in Viesta, located on the Italian mainland. A few zombies who survived inside the plane attacked other nearby Italian towns, infecting approximately 3,200 people. Meanwhile, under the orders of the Alpha zombie in the zombie army, they prevented communication with other cities, concealing the spread. From there, the zombie army headed towards Parco Nazianole del Garganio, using the forests to increase its numbers 25-fold to approximately 80,000.

Due to the Italian government's incompetence and lack of communication, the zombies quickly attacked southern Italian cities, taking over all of Italy except Rome and Sicily, located below the Arno River, increasing their numbers to approximately 2 million zombies.

During the evacuation of the Italians, French citizens were also waiting to be evacuated. However, due to chaos at the airport, approximately 10 people with French passports, including Algerians, Tunisians, and Moroccans, boarded the plane. This group of 10 people, who showed no symptoms, gradually began to exhibit some odd behavior while in flight and started turning into zombies 15 km away from Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport. After the plane made a safe landing at the airport, clashes broke out between security forces and zombies on the main runway and at the international gates, but the airport fell after the zombies surrounded the security forces.

Of the 2,500 infected individuals, 1,500 headed for rural settlements towards *Paris*, while the remaining 1,000-strong zombie army headed for the forests towards *Amiens*. Here, they created egg plantations covering an area of approximately 100 hectares to reproduce rapidly. Due to the area being covered in thick fog, communication was lost with French-made observation planes sent to the region for reconnaissance.

Meanwhile, the number of zombies advancing towards Paris reached approximately 15,000. After defeating the 20,000-strong motorized brigade sent against them, the zombie army, now numbering over 30,000, surrounded Paris from the northeast.

Approximately 40,000 zombies emerging from the egg plantations succeeded in taking the region of Amiens and began advancing toward the Benelux region. Fearing the occupation of

their territories, the armies of the Netherlands, Belgium, and Luxembourg joined forces to launch a lightning operation (Blitzkrieg) against the zombies, successfully pushing them out of part of the Amiens forests. Additionally, Germany, concerned about the approaching zombies, began deploying approximately 100,000 soldiers and necessary equipment to the French border.

Contrary to popular opinion, the virus did not only affect Europe but also America. Under a secret labor agreement between the United States and China, America was secretly supplying workers from China in containers. As the outbreak spread, the Chinese government decided to send many people under quarantine to work and brought them to Shanghai by truck. Approximately 80,000 Chinese people, secretly loaded into containers at the Shanghai port, set sail for the other side of the ocean, bound for the United States of America.

However, during the journey, some Chinese workers (temu) in the containers became infected, and a large part of the ship gradually became infected. In addition, due to abnormal weather conditions, control of the ship was completely lost. The ship, which had veered off course, crashed into the western coast of America. The zombie army, which quickly overpowered the rural security forces, grew to large numbers and headed for the national forests. They soon reached the Nevada state border and surrounded Santa Rosa. After a two-month siege, Santa Rosa fell. Meanwhile, the zombies did not stop and took over the north of San Francisco. With San Francisco also in danger, the US Army went on full alert. However, this was not a solution, and with the egg plantations, the number of zombies in the United States exceeded *4.5 million*.

To stop the zombies from advancing further, America set to work creating a new line of defense with a wall approximately 2,000 km long. Approximately 120,000 American men and women living in the region volunteered to participate in the work. Additionally, the Canadian and Mexican governments sent a group of soldiers from their national guard units to this region. New ammunition and weapons factories also began to be deployed immediately behind the new defense line.

While these developments were taking place in America, unexpected events occurred in Europe. German military units stationed on the German-French border spotted zombies on their side and launched an attack to eliminate them. However, a breakdown in communication between the teams allowed a few zombies to survive the horde. The group headed into the Ardennes forests and began establishing new zombie plantations. A week later, the change in the region was noticed by German air patrols. But it was too late. A newly formed zombie army, led by an alpha zombie, had surrounded Luxembourg, and the situation had become critical. However, the heroic resistance of the people of Luxembourg saved the city from destruction. But the zombies managed to infiltrate the city of Saarburghken on the German border via the sewage system. In response, the German government declared a national alert and established a New defense line (neue Verteidigungslinie) and a new army similar to that in America. The new Wehrmacht Army, with 50,000 active personnel, was the first unit to be deployed on this line.

While these events were unfolding in Germany, another major incident occurred in northeastern Europe. It happened on a passenger ship traveling from Copenhagen to Estonia. The ship lost control after everyone on board, including the captain, turned into zombies, this ship ran aground near Włodysławok in Poland. The event unfolded just like in Italy, and 90% of this narrow coastal strip of Poland was overrun by zombies. The Polish army, having retreated as far as the city of Szczecin, managed to stop the zombies there with the help of the local population. Following this, Poland declared a state of emergency and requested assistance from NATO. NATO immediately dispatched two infantry brigades, two mechanized brigades, and an air squadron to the region. In Poland, the central command brought in all the corps of the 2nd Army and the mechanized brigades of the 1st Army to the region. The city of Piła was designated as the main headquarters. To strengthen the left flank, the city of Szczecin was leased to the Germans in exchange for German assistance. The Germans reinforced the line by positioning their Baltic flotilla and German Eastern Army in this region. This created a new 230 km long defensive line stretching from Stettin (Szczecin) to Kraków before the zombie attack began.

In the final months of the year, a bigger shock came from the Balkan territories. A UN group of 20-30 people was sent to the area where the outbreak first started in Europe and began researching the region. However, After encountering zombies, they decided to pack their belongings, jump into boats, and retreat to Croatia. In Spilt, Croatia, soldiers on boats began turning into zombies one by one, causing panic among the population, and the virus slowly began to spread throughout the Balkans.

The first target of the Zombie UN unity was the 5th mobilized military base. The zombies succeeded with their plan, and approximately 80 infected individuals began entering the inner areas. Due to the failure of authorities and commanders to take action, the zombies managed to spread into Bosnia and Herzegovina. The zombies posed a serious threat because the majority of them were created by infecting military personnel. Following this, Serbia invited the states in the region -Croatia, Bosnia, Albania, Northern Macedonia, and Montenegro- to find a solution to this problem before the threat escalates further.

By meeting together, the delegates set aside their political differences and agreed on a common solution. According to this agreement, each state would use 8 percent of its active military personnel for the operation. Additionally, it was agreed that support units and surveillance airforce patrols would be established to prevent sudden zombie attacks, thus mitigating such a problem. The city of Tomislavgrad was also cleared of civilians and turned into a headquarters, and as a last resort, the city of Mostar (Bosnia) began similar preparations.

In addition, military units have summoned former Bulgarian President Rumen Radev to lead the army. Major General Rumen accepted the task, and the draft plan was finalized.

This is what happened to the world in the two years since the zombie virus outbreak began, but what's going to happen next?

*January 17, 2023* Signing of a defense treaty (Balkan Entente)

## **6. Global Impact Assessment**

### **a. Healthcare Collapse**

In the initial phase, hospitals may attempt to function under extreme pressure; however, they would become overwhelmed by mass casualties, infrastructure damage, and constant attacks by infected individuals. As a result, healthcare facilities would become weakened, marking the beginning of a total collapse of healthcare systems.

*Decimation of Medical Workforce:* A significant amount of healthcare professionals would be infected, killed, or unable to safely access medical facilities. This would create a severe shortage of trained personnel, further weakening the already fragile system. Lack of Medical

*Lack of Knowledge During Early Outbreak Stages:* At the early stages of the outbreak, the virus is entirely novel, and medical professionals have no prior knowledge or established treatment protocols to guide their response. As a result, doctors and researchers struggle to understand its transmission, symptoms, and progression, which significantly delays the development of effective medical interventions.

*Medical Supply Shortage:* Essential items and surgical tools would become nearly impossible to access or replenish. Without these resources, even basic medical interventions and research would become unmanageable. This prolongs the cure process.

*Hygiene Breakdown in Shelters:* In overcrowded shelters, maintaining basic hygiene becomes extremely difficult due to limited access to clean water and sanitation facilities. Poor hygiene conditions can lead to the spread of the virus and other illnesses also weakening survivors and increasing overall mortality rates.

*Psychological Collapse of Survivors and Staff:* Constant exposure to danger, loss, and uncertainty severely impacts mental health. Survivors and remaining healthcare workers may develop conditions such as PTSD, anxiety disorders, and paranoia. This psychological strain weakens survival efforts and makes it easier to believe propagandas.

*Ethical Breakdown in Medical Decisions:* With limited resources, decisions about who receives care and who is left behind become unavoidable. This leads to the erosion of medical ethics and places survivors in situations that conflict with fundamental human values.

## **b. Social Consequences**

*Traits of Zombies:* Infected patients have the ability to remember their former human lives. For example, those who were from the military before infection may still demonstrate their military skills such as weapon familiarity and tactical movement.

*Impairment of Social Order:* As a consequence of the survival instinct triggered by the pandemic, the breakdown of law and order has escalated. Looting and violence rates have reached alarming levels. Basic security is nonexistent in many areas.

*Psychological Disorders:* The trauma of invasion strikes a global health crisis. Survivors are having PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder), schizophrenia, anxiety and other mental illnesses. Invest for psychologists' wellness to keep the mental health stable.

*Disruption of Education:* The disruption of education has hampered millions of children's access to school. This loss will affect the long-term recovery after pandemic.

*Economic Collapse:* Pandemic caused a global economic collapse. Businesses have shut down, commerce has slowed down and the unemployment rate has maximized.

## **i. Political Implications**

*Erosion of Trust in Government:* In states where the government fails to take necessary precautions, rebellions and internal unrest may emerge leading to uprisings against the authorities. This may cause impairment of social order.

*Spread of Misinformation and Propagandas:* Zombie propaganda and misinformation campaigns aspire to undermine human resistance and demoralize the population. To prevent demoralization, invest in media literacy.

## **ii. Global Migration and Refugee Crises**

The outrage has created a massive wave of displaced people seeking safer zones. Overcrowded shelters lack basic sanitation, medical care and security. An extensive plan for refugee resettlement, resource allocation and security maximization is urgently needed.

*Balkan Resilience and Population Displacement Protocol (BRPD)*: According to this joint declaration signed by the Balkan states in Tomislavgrad, the regional geography has been categorized into three strategic zones: Red (Evacuation), Yellow (Controlled), and Green (Safe). As an immediate first step, "Red Zones" that are impossible to defend against the zombie threat—such as Split and the Adriatic coastline—have been completely evacuated. Through an "Urban Depopulation" strategy, civilian populations have been redirected to the interior regions. The primary goal of this strategy is to prevent crowded cities from becoming massive "feeding and breeding grounds" for zombie hordes, instead dispersing human masses into smaller, more defensible settlements.

### c. Critical Countries

- **China:** The pandemic started in China. Therefore, China plays an important role in research (treatment and vaccine) and in achieving "patient zero". Furthermore, China could face serious criticism from the media if it does not provide support to other countries.
- **USA:** The epidemic started in America when one of the ships involved in the agreement with China ran aground. The national government has to contend with this problem on one hand, and on the other hand, with the Opposition. Lastly, the defense line being built is also putting a significant strain on the USA's budget.
- **Italy:** Italy was the country worst affected by the pandemic worldwide. As the virus began spreading across Europe, Italy lost 70% of its territory in less than a month. Italy, having designated Bergamo as its new capital, will also be trying to protect its last territories.
- **France-Germany:** These two states, considered giants of Central Europe, are fighting the virus while also working on a cure. The main objective of both countries is to destroy zombies and prevent unexpected situations from arising.
- **Croatia:** The virus spread to coastal areas after a flour mill returning from Italy became infected. As a result, the Croatian government and other Balkan states signed

a joint aid agreement. According to this agreement, a new defense line will be established, and former Bulgarian President, Major General Rumen Radev has been appointed as its commander.

- **Russia:** With the outbreak of the epidemic in Poland, which borders Kaliningrad, the Russian army is on semi-alert. The Russian army, having sent the Baltic Flitolla and twenty thousand soldiers reserve troops to the region, will protect this territory and is ready to assist Poland if needed.
- **UK:** The British on the British Isles are closely monitoring the zombie invasion in neighboring France. The British General Staff is constantly on alert, preparing exercise plans. In case of a disaster in Europe, a portion of the reserve unit is kept on standby in Brighton Port.

#### d. Questions to Be Addressed

- What can countries do if the pandemic worsens?
- What can countries do to develop treatments and vaccines against the pandemic?
- What alternatives to defensive lines can countries develop as part of their defense strategy?
- What can the WHO do to work more closely with countries?
- How can NATO, EU and other organizations improve their assistance to countries during the pandemic?
